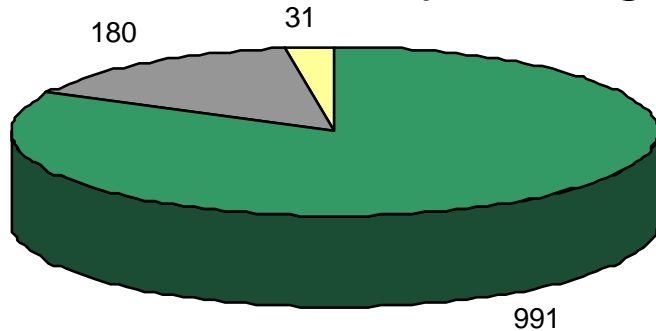

**earn credits that will transfer**

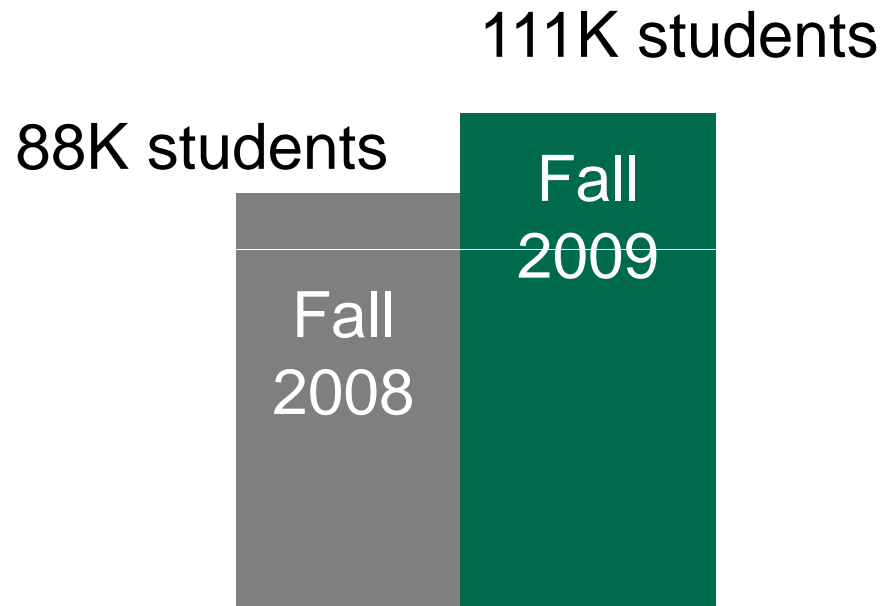
to a four (4) year college.

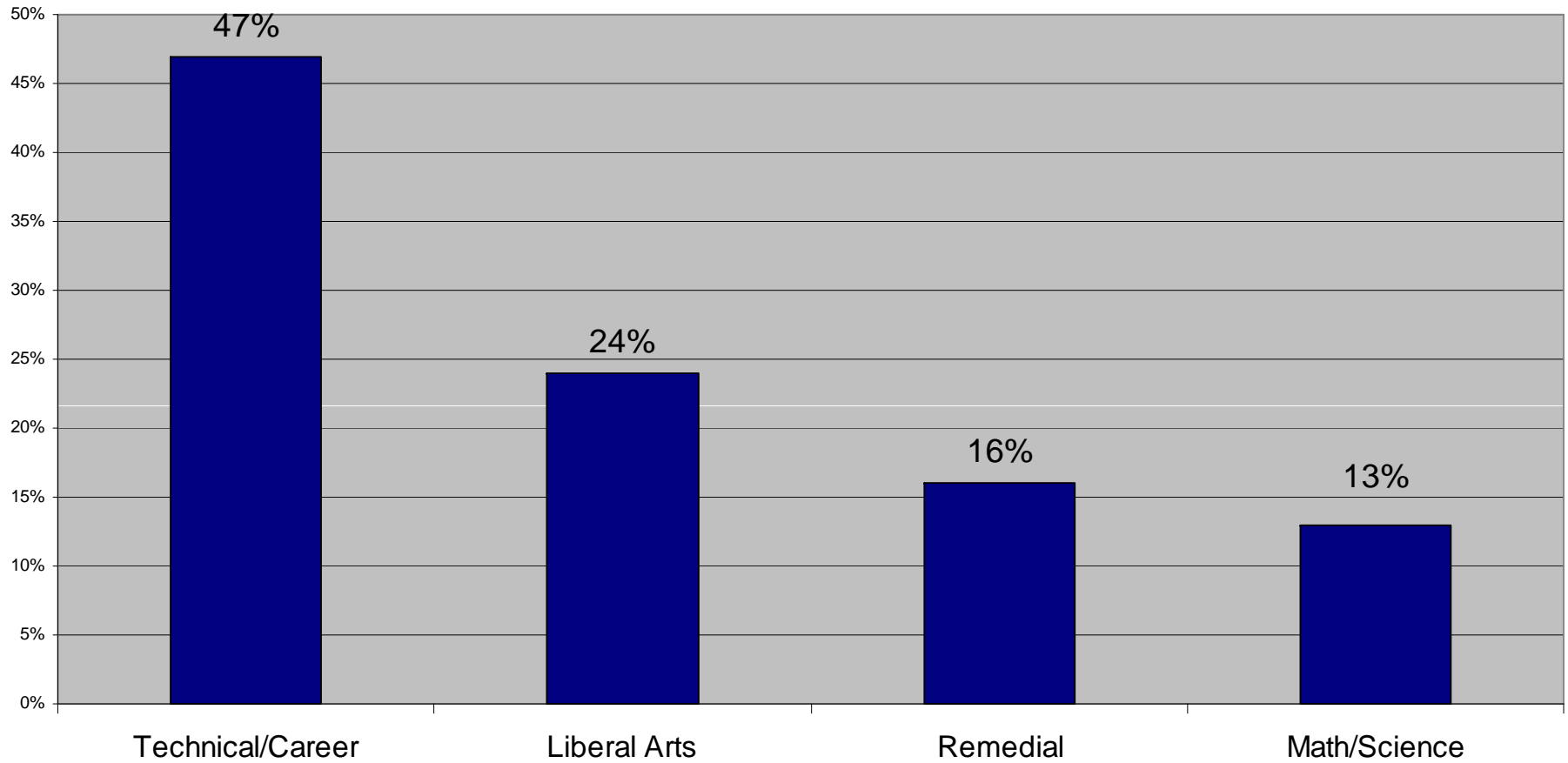
