







What is OER?

Open Educational Resources (OER) are teaching and learning materials that you may freely use and reuse at no cost, and without needing to ask permission.



RETAIN

Faculty and students should be able to keep the resource



REUSE

Faculty and students should be able to reuse the resource

Resource should be able to be edited, modified, or tweaked

THE 5 Rs OF OER

REVISE




REMIX

Resource should be able to be remixed

REDISTRIBUTE Resource should be able to be redistributed through print, e-mail, etc










- Instructors can customize or update content



STUDENT SUCCESS WITH OPEN AND AFFORDABLE RESOURCES

This course will provide a beginner-level overview of how student success relates to open educational resources (OER) through the lens of who, what, where, when, why, and how. Participants will examine the problem with the current textbook publishing model, investigate student and faculty perceptions, identify stakeholders within their own institutions, review trends in the Wisconsin and higher education landscape, explore available resources, and begin a plan to get them started on their own OER journey.






DUAL CREDIT IN HIGH SCHOOLS

CVTC and area school districts continue to expand opportunities for high school students to earn both high school and college credit in a variety of programs. Over the last five years we have seen significant growth in dual enrollment programs. Researchers have identified numerous advantages in earning dual credit, including cost savings, early entry to career pathways, decreased college remediation, reduced time to degree completion and stronger postsecondary outcomes.





OER and Dual Enrollment in Health Programs


